	 V. Low says the building floor plan has not changed since the last meeting. D. Kalis asks about the generator and what's above the stone on the wall. V. Low says they are painted aluminum panels above the stone. L. Zinner asks about the noise level of the generator. J. Morse says he will get info on the decibel rating for the generator. P. Barrer asks about the budget and where they stand. J. Morse responds saying the MSBA voted to increase the reimbursements for communities currently in the core program pipeline. Says the maximum reimbursement would be just shy of \$21 million if everything goes the right way. Says the total project budget is just under \$76 million and estimating \$6 million in rebates and incentives which would put them at about \$69 million. P. Barrer asks about the test result for the wells. J. Morse says they haven't gotten the results back yet. E. Light asks about the budget being translated into a square footage cost. J. Morse and S. Brown say it's about \$800 per square foot for construction costs. A. Valcarce goes over items that are for further study during design development in the slideshow.
